DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

International Students

Academic Documents

- Letter of Acceptance from a designated learning institution (DLI)
- Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL/TAL), where required
- All academic transcripts, diplomas, and degrees
- Language test results (IELTS, PTE, TOEFL, etc.)

Financial Documents

- Proof of first-year tuition payment or capacity to pay
- Guaranteed Investment Certificate (GIC), if applicable
- Bank statements of sponsor/parents (4–6 months)
- Education loan sanction letter (if applicable)
- Sponsor's income proof and sponsorship/affidavit of support letter

Personal Documents

- Valid passport
- Two photos meeting IRCC specifications
- Study plan / statement of purpose
- Immigration medical exam (if required for your country)
- Police clearance certificate (if requested)
