DOCUMENT CHECKLIST

Parents & Grandparents — stays up to 5 years

Applicant (Parent/Grandparent) Documents

- Valid passport (copies of all stamped pages)
- Two photos meeting IRCC specifications
- Completed immigration medical exam (IME) from a panel physician
- Proof of relationship to host (birth certificates showing lineage)

Host (Child/Grandchild) Documents

- Invitation letter promising financial support for the stay
- Proof of status: PR card or Canadian citizenship/passport
- Proof of income meeting LICO: Notice of Assessment, T4, employment letter
- List of household members (for family-size LICO calculation)

Insurance & Finances

- Canadian medical insurance: minimum \$100,000 coverage, valid 1 year
- Proof insurance is fully paid (not just quoted)
- Applicant's bank statements (4–6 months)

Ties to Home Country

- Property, pension, or business documents in home country
- Other family members remaining at home
